


Parent/Carer Survey Feedback Autumn 2023

My child is happy at a Trust school



The school's ethos and culture have a positive effect on my child



My child feels safe at school





The school encourages its children to be respectful and caring






"The buddy system especially and the interaction between year groups here is very nurturing and creates a lovely whole-school community."

The school ensures its children are well behaved




Unfortunately, despite our positive behaviour approach, occasionally some children may have experienced bullying, where this happens we strive to deal with it, below are comments from you:

- We experienced this with my child last year, but the teachers were brilliant when I brought it to their attention and seemed to deal with it quickly and updated me daily on what had been done and anything that had happened
- We appreciate the schools approach on this. And also really pleased teachers can feel they can come to us if our own children have not behaved in an appropriate way so that we can speak about it with them.
- Many members of staff have handled any incident my child has had wonderfully. My child has been made to feel secure and told they can speak up when people aren't being kind. They are very caring and extremely supportive.



When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with in line with our complaints policy




Whilst it is pleasing that 91% (increase by 4% on last year) of our parent community have either not raised a concern or are happy with how any concern has been dealt with, we still have work to do to address the 9% who do not feel that concerns have been addressed properly. This will be an area for individual schools to look at closely.

We have appreciated the support and initiative taken and know our child is in great hands."



How strongly do you agree with this statement? "My child has SEND and the school gives them the support they need to




Although we are delighted to see an increase in parents and carers agreeing with this statement, this is a key area of focus for us during 2023-24.

The school has high expectations for my child




We have high expectations for our children and therefore 87% demonstrates that we have some work to do to realise our core belief 'Realising the Possible'

"Happy memories are being created everyday, whilst giving them a great educational start"


My child is flourishing at school

The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year






The school lets me know how my child is doing

My child has access to the full range of national curriculum subjects




This figure represents a significant improvement up by 11% on last year, and we are pleased that our children are receiving a broad and balanced curriculum offer and experiencing a full range of subjects.





The school supports my child to take part in a wide range of activities and experiences across and beyond the curriculum




